

RULES GOVERNING THE PARTICIPATION IN THE EUROPEAN REMEMBRANCE SYMPOSIUM 2019 AND THE SUBSEQUENT DISCUSSIONS, ORGANISED BY THE INSTITUTE OF THE EUROPEAN NETWORK REMEMBRANCE AND SOLIDARITY

1. These rules (hereinafter the '**Rules**') lay down the principles and conditions of your participation in the European Remembrance Symposium 2019 and the subsequent discussions (hereinafter the '**Events**') organised by the Institute of the European Network Remembrance and Solidarity seated in Warsaw, acting on the basis of an entry into the register of institutions of culture kept by the Minister of Culture and National Heritage under the number of RIK 90/2015 (hereinafter the '**Institute**').
2. In order to participate in the Events organised by the Institute, you should be at least 16 years of age.
3. The Institute shall promote the Events which shall involve dissemination of the personal data of their participants (including, *inter alia*, their first names, surnames and images). Such promotion shall be executed, *inter alia*, by means of the Newsletter of the Institute and the Foundation European Network 'Remembrance and Solidarity', social media (Facebook, Twitter), YouTube, the official website of the Institute and press releases sent to the media., as well as on the newsletters, official websites, social media and YouTube of the Ministry of Culture and National Heritage of the Republic of Poland (with its registered seat in Warsaw, 00-071, Poland, Krakowskie Przedmieście 15/17) and Partners of the Event *inter alia*: The Mémorial de la Shoah, France, The Institute of Contemporary History (USD), Czech Rep., The Herder Institute for Historical Research on East Central Europe, Germany, The Committee of National Remembrance (NEB), Hungary, The Federal Institute for Culture and History of the Germans in Eastern Europe (BKGE), Germany, The European Observatory on Memories (EUROM), Spain, Fundació Solidaritat Universitat de Barcelona, Spain, The European Solidarity Centre (ECS), Poland, The Polish History Museum (MHP), Poland, The European Centre for Sociology and Political Science (CESSP), France.
4. In order to organise the Events, the Institute cooperates with third parties to which it makes available the personal data you have submitted in a scope related to such cooperation.
5. If the costs of your participation in the Events are covered with using funds acquired from third parties, the Institute shall transfer your personal data to such parties or intermediaries in funding acquisition for a purpose and in a scope necessary for the Institute's performance of required financial settlements.
6. Upon signing these Rules, you shall grant your consent as regards multiple dissemination by the Institute, unlimited in terms of time and territory as well as free of charge, of your image featuring in the photographs, audio or audio-visual materials, acquired or created in the context of the events to which you subscribed, regardless of the form of their dissemination, including, *inter alia*, by means of IT tools and mass media, including the right of the said Institute to grant on your behalf consent for third parties to its (i.e. of your image) dissemination, for the purposes of promotion of the said events.
7. The signing of these Rules, shall mean that you wish to participate in the Events and that you give your consent to the provisions of these Rules.
